## **NURTURE HOME**

Our response to women who are homeless with a mental illness. Is Nurture Home, which provides a safe place to thrive and restore within the Aiken community.



- 12 Volunteers
- MHAA facility-home
  - Kitchen
  - Living room 4 bathrooms
  - 13 beds
  - Washer/Dryer
  - Computer
  - Security/Fire
  - Systems
- MHA Cottage
  - A stepdown traditional standalone residence.
- Thriving Together Aftercare Program
- United Way of Aiken County funding Grants
  - Individuals
  - Churches
  - Fundraisers

24-hour supervision is provided to increase likelihood resident will exit successfully into permanent housing.

Activities

- Weekly one-on-one sessions.
  - Screen residents for all eligible benefits.
- Volunteer activities vear-round for social interaction and positive role modeling opportunities.
- Job skill classes
  - Resume
  - Interviewing
  - Budgeting

Women who are homeless with a mental illness are eligible.

OUTPUTS

- Women who achieve stability in NH program are eligible for after-care/ occupancy of The Cottage.
- Residents participate in development of their treatment plan.
- Residents • participate in all Life Skills. Counseling, or Group Activity.
- Staff and Executive Director continuously discuss progress or concerns of residents.

## **OUTCOMES**

- 2,920 nights of lodging.
- Residents were females with mental illness.
- 6,570 meals served.
- 29,565 meals were • given away.
- 4 residents found jobs in 2023.
- Nurture Home is completely full and has a waiting list.
- All residents obtained ID 's and documents.
- Improved mental health and overall wellness.
- Aftercare program served 37.



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
